Undergraduate (UG) Programs

Admissions are based on CUET-UG 2026 scores. UG programs include various B.A. (Hons), B.Sc. (Hons), and B.A. Programme options, as well as B.Com (Hons) and B.Sc. Physical Sciences with specializations.

Postgraduate (PG) Programs

Admissions are based on CUET-PG 2026 scores. PG programs offered include M.A., M.Sc., and M.Com.

Short-Term & Certificate Courses

The college provides several certificate courses for 2026, including foreign languages such as French, German, Russian, and Spanish. Skill-based certificates are also available in areas like Sustainable Perfumery, Public Policy, Green Chemistry, Machine Learning, Science of Happiness, and Climate, Ecosystems and Sustainability. More details on these courses can be found in the referenced documents.

Undergraduate (UG) Eligibility (CUET-UG 2026)

Candidates need to have passed Class 12 or an equivalent from a recognized board, generally with a minimum aggregate of 50% marks. Appearance in CUET-UG 2026 is mandatory. The subject mapping rule requires candidates to take CUET subjects they have passed in Class 12.

Specific course requirements include combinations of languages, Mathematics, Accountancy, and other subjects from lists specified by DU/CUET for programs like B.A. (Hons.) Economics, B.Com. (Hons.), and various B.Sc. (Hons.) degrees. Some science programs also require a minimum 30% score in one language from List A.

Postgraduate (PG) Eligibility (CUET-PG 2026)

Eligibility requires a relevant Bachelor's degree from a recognized university. Minimum aggregate marks in graduation are typically 50% for General/OBC/EWS and 45% for SC/ST/PwBD categories. Admission is based on CUET-PG 2026 scores, with potential priority for DU graduates for 50% of the seats based on merit.

Category Relaxations & Quotas

Reservation policies apply, including 15% for SC, 7.5% for ST, 27% for OBC-NCL, 10% for EWS, and 5% for PwBD. The Sports/ECA quota considers a combined score from the CUET exam (25%) and performance/certificate trials (75%). There is no upper age limit for admission to DU's UG or PG programs.



Undergraduate (UG) Annual Fees (Year 1)

For 2026 admissions, students in most categories pay similar academic fees, with specific concessions for PwBD candidates.

Postgraduate (PG) Annual Fees (Year 1)

PG fees for the 2025–26 session are generally lower than UG fees and also provide concessions for reserved categories.

- M.A. / M.Com: ₹25,800 – ₹27,976 per year.
- M.Sc.: ₹25,900 – ₹27,976 per year.

Hostel Fees (2025–26 Session)

Hostel seats are merit-based and limited. The fees below are for the entire first year (two semesters), including mess charges.

- Semester I: ₹75,800 (includes ₹4,000 refundable security).
- Semester II: ₹71,800.
- Annual Total: Approximately ₹1,47,600.

Additional Mandatory Charges

- Examination Fees: Paid per semester, typically ranging from ₹1,000 to ₹2,000.
- CUET 2026 Registration: General (₹750–₹1,000), OBC-NCL/EWS (₹700–₹900), SC/ST/PwBD (₹650–₹800) depending on the number of subjects.

*Note: Cutoff scores vary significantly across categories (OBC, SC, ST, EWS) and rounds. For 2026, students should aim for a **98-100 percentile** for top-tier courses at Hindu College.*
